

About Us: We are a small and very caring establishment. We are a family run business, designed to give your pet a luxurious and stress free stay. We decided to keep the establishment small, to ensure enough time can be spent settling each animal in, to make sure that they enjoy their holiday too! Having been open since the year 2000 we have enjoyed the company of many animals, most of whom return on a regular basis, so early booking is recommended. Viewing is encouraged between the hours of 10am-12noon, Mon-Sat. When we will look forward to showing you around.

Dogs: Country kennels and cattery is set in 200 acres of farm and woodland where the dogs are walked at least twice daily, in securely fenced paddocks or woodland. Older, quieter or more nervous dogs can be walked individually.

Each Kennel is designed to give your dog a similar surrounding to their own home, with curtains at the windows, a chair, and a rug on the floor. A television is left on during the day for company and familiarity. Rubber toys are supplied to keep your dog occupied between walks, and there are bedtime bonios for those who wish to partake.

Cats: They have their own building well away from the kennels. They have heated houses to snuggle into or they may prefer to roam in their large, individual runs, where they can look out over the Conwy Valley and on to the beauty of the Carneddu Mountains. Again the cats well-being is first and foremost, our time will be spend settling them in, and daily attention will be given.

More information: The main building is well insulated to be cool in the summer and warm in the winter and each kennel and cat house has its own heating. The kennels have observation cameras and a two way intercom system, and the Cattery can be seen from our sitting room window.

All kennels and cat pens are cleaned and each animal is checked over daily. Every care is given to ensure a happy, and stress free stay, your pets happiness is our first priority.

All animals are fed twice daily and special diets can be catered for. Diabetics and animals needing extra medical attention are taken by special arrangement & must be arranged at the time of booking. For your pets comfort, you are welcome to bring any bedding or toys they are accustomed to.

To help with the smooth running of the kennels and cattery we request:

- all animals depart between 10am-11am
 - all animals arrive between 11am-12noon
 - all animals need to be fully vaccinated - and dogs to have the kennel cough vaccination. **Certificates must be shown on every visit.**
 - Collection and delivery by special arrangement
 - during periods of adverse weather, we will meet you at a suitable location
- Emergency veterinary services available 24 hours a day.

Tariff:

(all animals will be charged for the day of arrival, but not the day of departure, provided they leave before 11am)

Cats: £6.00 per day

Dogs: £11.00 per day

From the 1st of March 2013

Cats: £6.50

Dogs: £12.00

There is a small discount given for more than one animal sharing the same kennel/cat pen.

Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Year's Day will be charged at double our usual tariff.

Shell garage (off A55 junction 19)
Glan Conwy Corner

Route 1:

From the shell garage follow signs for **Bodnant gardens**. When you reach Bodnant gardens go straight into the village of Eglwysbach. When you reach the post office on your left, continue for 2.0 miles approx. You will then come to a steep hill. Country Kennels and Cattery will be the second turning on the left, $\frac{1}{2}$ mile up the steep hill.

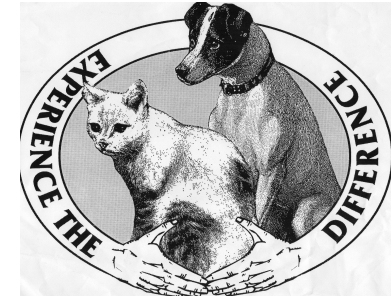
Route 2:

Straight up hill from the roundabout all the way up to the T-Junction. Turn right onto the **B5113** towards Llanrwst. Carry on until you get to the Holland Arms pub. Continue on this road for $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles until you reach the crossroads. Turn right. Travel $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, go round sharp right hand bend. Our drive is on the right.

From Abergele:

Turn up the side of the George and Dragon Pub towards LlanfairTH. On to Llanfair Rd. Continue for 10miles until you reach the village of Llangernyw. You will see the Stag pub in front of you. Turn right opposite the Stag and continue until you reach the crossroads. Go straight over the crossroads and continue for $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, go round sharp right hand bend and our drive is on the right.
